

ADULT LEAGUE TEAM FORMING TIPS

Q: How do I form a team?

- Gather friends, coworkers, family- anyone and coordinate a captain
- Typical teams try to have atleast 14 players (but vary depending on schedules so that enough substitutes will be available at each game)
- Have the captain or representative contact the league coordinator for basic information and updates on how many current teams in league
- Captain or representative must attend the Captain's Meeting April 14 at 7pm at the Midland Soccer Complex

Q: What are the responsibilities of a captain?

- Keep consistent communication with team, deliver messages and/or updates from league coordinators to your team
- Help remind players on team to register and help league coordinator with team player card notifications and/or creations
- Coordinate with team regarding jerseys- notify leagm/her that ue coordinator of color choice so no duplicates in league
- Help league coordinator with keeping track of cards/points/suspensions of team
- Turn in roster to league coordinator by April 25
- Bring roster and players cards to each game
- Collect all player cards at end of season and turn into office

Q: What if I don't have a team to sign up with?

- Not a problem! We love having new players!
- Register online and put in the comment box to be on a "House Team"
- Email the league coordinator and notify him/her that you would like to be placed on a team. If enough players register independently, they will be placed into a "House Team". If not enough for a full team, then those individual players will be contacted by existing captains to inquire about joining their team.
