

Midland Soccer Club 2023 9 vs 9 Co-ed Summer League

League Rules: (Specific to 8v8 Co-ed. Supplemental to MSC standard rules.)

- 1. Co-ed 9 vs 9 Open (anyone over 19 in current year) soccer league will be an 8-10 game season.
 - a. Games held Tuesday evenings.
 - b. Games will start at 7:00pm in Spring and 6:00pm in Fall
 - c. Players may be added throughout the season.
 - d. League must have at least 4 teams to run.
 - e. For leagues with 4 or 5 teams, there will be only one final match. For leagues 6 or more, there will be a semi final and final match.
- 2. A league registrar will coordinate this league.
 - a. Organize captain's meeting.
 - b. Ensure league schedule is created and posted.
 - c. Coordinate any schedule changes.
 - d. Scores recorded and made available.
 - e. Communicate to captains during the season.
- 3. The game will be played on 9v9 fields (fields G, H, J, etc.) with one center referee.
- 4. Suggested roster size will be 14 players maximum.
 - a. This number coincides with the addition of Game Rule 7 (below). The roster max for 9v9 is 16 with the addition of "on field" female requirement
- 5. Player fee is designated on the website
- 6. Captains are responsible for Team shirts.
 - a. No number necessary.
 - b. Shirts must be primarily the team's color. Team color may be suggested by captains and confirmed by league registrar.
 - c. Teams may purchase and utilize recreation league jerseys (green/white reversible).

Game Rules: (Specific to 9v9 Co-ed. Supplemental to MSC standard rules.)

- 1. Games will be two 35-minute halves.
- 2. Each player will have a player card. Captains are responsible for presenting these player cards.
 - a. Player cards may be from previous sessions or new ones issued this season. Cards must have the registration sticker signifying the player has paid.
- 3. Each player must be wearing team colored shirt, shin pads, socks and soccer appropriate cleats.
- 4. Roster sheets must be provided to referees by captains at the beginning of each game.
- 5. Team must start the game with a minimum of 6 players or forfeit the game.
- 6. A **minimum of 1 female** must always be on the field.
 - a. This rule is new and reflects MSC's goal to incorporate a true "Co-Ed" league. This rule will be enforced.
 - b. Captains may agree to play with an adjusted female requirement. Captains must notify the official of this agreement.
 - c. Teams may play short if they cannot meet this requirement.

7. No slide tackling allowed.

- a. Sliding will be up to the interpretation of the referee. Captains should do their best to work with their teams so this is not an issue.
- 8. Unlimited substitutions are allowed. Ensure substitutes enter from the halfway line, only when waved on by the official.
- 9. Standard Laws of the Game apply with following additional rule(s):
 - a. Offside is up to the discretion of the singular center referee. Please be honorable and understand this will be difficult to manage.
